Because we are now a 501(C)(3), we have to fill a tax form annually for the Feds. Nobody volunteered so it was motioned to have this done by a tax preparer.

Elections for President & Vice President will be held at the May meeting. For health reasons, Vice President Ed W. does not want to run. We congratulated him on the wonderful job he has done the last several years!
